Dr. Rescorla developed the *Language Development Survey (LDS)*, a screening tool for language delay in toddlers. Both individuals are the authors of numerous chapters and journal articles on assessment and prevention of children's emotional and behavioral problems.

What: Dr. McConaughy and Dr. Rescorla will discuss a comprehensive assessment system for evaluating students with behavioral and emotional disorders. They will provide an overview of the ASEBA comprehensive assessment model, use of the school age forms CBCL, TRF, and YSR and Preschool forms as well as a semi structured clinical interview and observational measures. Video case examples will be shared for the various measures. Progress monitoring using these assessment tools will be introduced as part of the RTI model for students with emotional and behavioral disorders.
